All courses are offered Monday through Friday. All remedial classes offer thirty hours of instruction and are taught by state certified instructors. Students and parents should understand that the above listed times may have to be changed to accommodate the addition or deletion of courses. **Some courses may not run due to insufficient enrollment.**

Registration may be done by mail or in person on June 29th and July 1st from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon in the office at Scituate High School.

Course Fee: \$125.00 This fee is non-refundable unless a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.

Non-Scituate Residents - \$140.00

Checks should be made payable to Scituate Summer School.

If it should be necessary to restrict enrollment in a course, Scituate residents will be given preference on a first come, first served basis.

SUMMER SCHOOL RULES

1. No smoking **anywhere** on the campus. This includes the parking lots.
2. No visitors are allowed on the campus except to pick up or drop off students. If there is an emergency situation, persons needing to contact a student should report directly to the high school office.
3. No loitering in the parking lot. Upon arrival students are to report to the bus loading platform until admitted to class. Following class, students are expected to leave the campus **immediately**.
4. Between classes the only area where students may congregate is the bus loading platform.
5. Students are to park only in the student parking lot located in front of the school.
6. No credit for any course will be given until all materials are returned or paid for.
7. A **maximum** of two absences from class are allowed. Two latenesses to class equal one absence. A student more than 10 minutes late to class will be counted as absent. All absences and latenesses count. No excuses.
8. All other normal school rules apply: drugs, alcohol, student behavior, etc.

WHETHER ON THE FIRST OR FIFTEENTH DAY, A VIOLATION OF SUMMER SCHOOL RULES WILL RESULT IN **DISMISSAL FROM SUMMER SCHOOL** WITH NO REFUND OF TUITION OR CLASS CREDIT.
